

Further Asian expansion for metrology leader

Renishaw, a world leader in metrology and spectroscopy, is expanding its presence in Asia with the opening of more subsidiary and Representative Offices.

In Singapore, where Renishaw has been operating a Representative Office for 12 years, the status of the office has been changed to that of a formal subsidiary. With responsibility for serving OEM customers and end-users in the South East Asian region, Renishaw (Singapore) Pte Ltd will take on the role of direct selling by the end of 2007.

A new Representative Office has also been opened in Kuala Lumpur to support Renishaw's rapidly expanding customer base in Malaysia.

Speaking about his company's expansion, Paul Gallagher, Renishaw's General Manager – South East Asia said, "Our business in Asia has been increasing steadily and these changes will allow us to better serve our customers and provide more local technical support."

Renishaw supplies a wide range of market leading metrology products, including CMM probe systems and controllers, touch probes and laser tool setters for CNC machine tools, linear and rotary encoders for position feedback, calibration systems for machine performance analysis, and Raman Spectroscopy systems for spectral analysis.

The Renishaw Group currently has offices in 31 countries, with total employee numbers now over 2,100. For the year-ended June 2006, worldwide sales totalled £175 million (US\$350 million).

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
