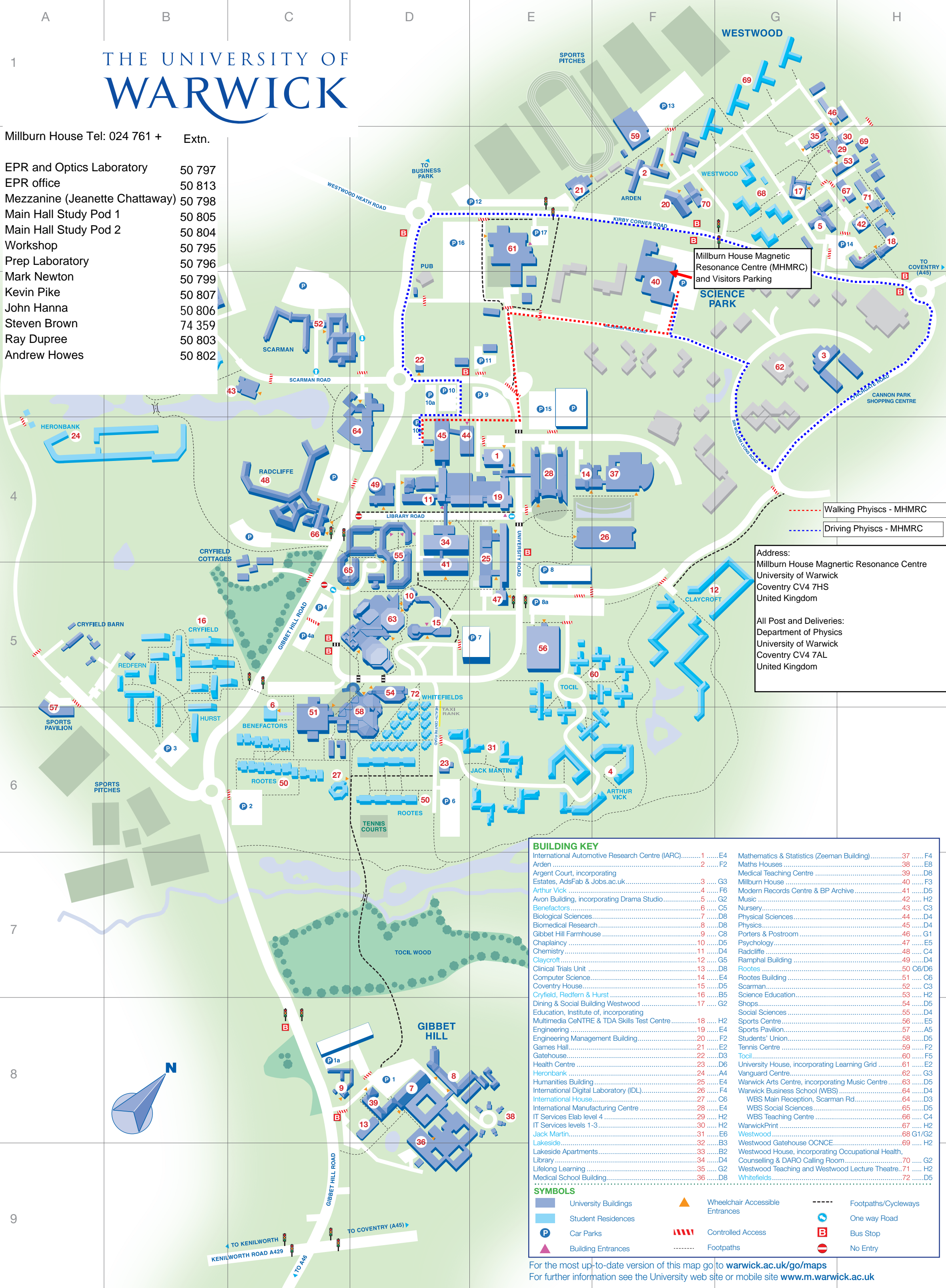

- From the North
 - From M69/M6 interchange (M6 Jct 2) take A46 towards Warwick and Coventry

- After approx 3.5 miles you will reach Tollbar End roundabout (junction with A45).
- At the roundabout, follow signs for A45 Birmingham.
- After approx 3 miles you will cross the A429 (Kenilworth Road). Half a mile after this junction take the left-hand turn signposted 'University of Warwick'. Follow signs for University of Warwick (and Warwick Arts Centre) across two roundabouts. You are now approaching The University of Warwick from Kirby Corner Road.

- From M45 Jct 1 take A45 towards Coventry.

- After approx 7 miles you will reach Tollbar End roundabout (junction with A46) follow signs for A45 Birmingham.
- Now follow the directions given in the final bulletpoint above.

- From M40 Jct 15 take A46 towards Coventry.

- After approximately 8 miles leave A46 at junction signposted 'University of Warwick and Stoneleigh'.
- After a further 1.5 miles you will cross the A429 (Kenilworth Road). You are now approaching The University of Warwick from Gibbet Hill Road

- From M42 Jct 6 take A45 towards Coventry.

- After approximately 9 miles you will pass a large Sainsbury store on your left.
- At the next roundabout (Fire Station on right), take the right-hand exit, signposted '(University and Canal)'. Follow signs for University of Warwick (and Warwick Arts Centre) across two roundabouts. You are now approaching The University of Warwick from Kirby Corner Road.

Approx 30 mins by taxi from Birmingham International Airport.

By Rail (nearest station is Coventry)
Approx 15 mins by taxi from Coventry railway station or take the Travel Coventry 12 bus from the Warwick Road (follow signs from the station).
